Twinco Aircraft *Must* Be Pre-heated when Temperatures Fall Below 30 Degrees F.

Pre-Heater Instructions

- 1. Install flex duct in pilot side cowl opening leave other cowl plug installed. *Do Not* connect flex duct to heater yet!
- 2. Connect cigarette lighter power cord to car fan must run. Some cars might require key to be on or in accessory position.
- 3. Open valve on propane tank.
- 4. Press down on red button and push igniter. Once burning, *continue to hold button* for 20 seconds. Monitor that heater continues to burn without interruption
- 5. Once heater is running, connect the flex duct and run for the time outlined below.
- 6. To shut down, *close the propane tank first* and continue to run fan until heater is Cool.
- 7. Disconnect power cord and stow heater in doghouse neatly.

Twinco Aircraft *Must* Be Pre-heated when Temperatures Fall Below 30 Degrees F. Take into account overnight lows for early morning activities. Pre-Heat Times are as follows:

Temperature	Minimum Pre-Heat Time
25 to 30 deg F	15 Min. Minimum
15 to 25 deg F	30 Min. Minimum
10 to 15 deg F	45 Min. Minimum
